

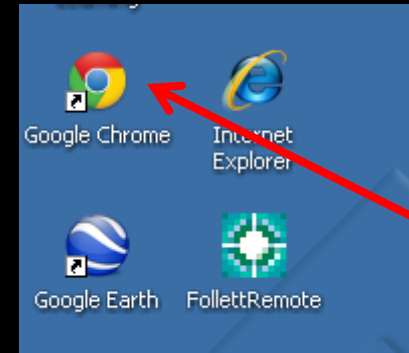

HOW TO FIND BOOKS ON YOUR LEXILE

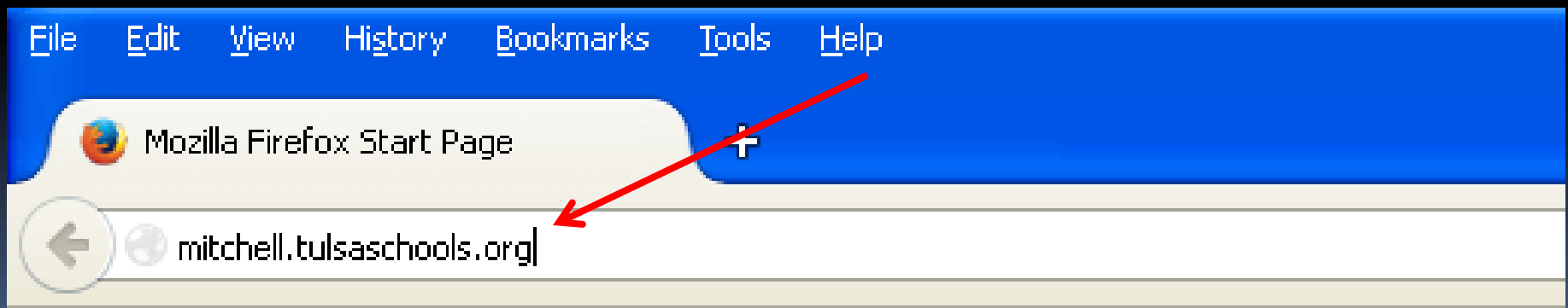
Step 1: Open Mitchell Website

 - Open Google Chrome (the beach ball)




- IF you're NOT in the library

Step 2: Open Catalog
